TUITION PAYMENTS FOR 2010-2011

Since some families have indicated that they do not need a tuition statement, we are only sending out statements to new families and financial assistance families. Please review the tuition schedule attached to this newsletter and make arrangements for payments. If you are already on the FACTS program, we will promote your account accordingly with the new rates. If you are paying in 2 payments, your first payment is due Thursday, July 15 and the second payment is due Thursday, December 16. If you are paying in full, your payment is due Thursday, July 15. We will offer discounts of \$100 for pay in full, and \$50 for 2 payments, only if you pay by cash or check. We will be happy to accept your credit cards, VISA, MC, American Express or Discover, but we will not be able to offer a discount on the credit card payments. If you would like us to send you a statement by email or mail, or if you have any other questions, just give us a call or email us.
